In one of the tightest finishes in Cup history, the top nine cars finished within a second of one another. And all nine, including race winner Jimmie Johnson's #48 Chevrolet, were equipped with MOOG steering and suspension parts.

"It was a fantastic finish for the drivers, the fans and the MOOG brand," Nelson said.
